Notice to Exhibitors

- ☆ Safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this event, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of agility, obedience, and rally and that their dogs are familiar with and will be able to perform all obstacles and exercises safely.
- ☆ All exhibitors are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dog and/or child engages in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Event Committee or York Expo Center management, be asked to leave the event site. In such case, no refund of entry fees will be made.
- ☆ Dogs must be on leash at all times at the host hotel and on event grounds except when in the ring or within the designated warm-up areas. All Star will follow AKC rules regarding collars on the show grounds.
- ☆ Due to the difficulty in finding sites, exhibitors must clean up after their dogs and use only designated potty areas at the competition site and hotels. Failure to comply shall result in expulsion from competition and forfeiture of entry.
- ☆ Crate space is limited. ***Absolutely no ex-pens will be allowed in the building.*** Unentered dogs may be on site, but their crates must be stacked on those of entered dogs. No saving of spaces will be permitted. To be fair to all dogs, exhibitors of dogs who are disruptive in the crating area (including excessive barking) will be asked to resolve the problem or they may be asked to remove the dog from the crating area. ASPDA reserves the right to limit the size of individuals' crating areas.
- ☆ The event site will be available Thursday for crates. Times will be published in the judging schedule. Dogs must be removed from the site immediately following the end of competition on Sunday. Dogs cannot be left overnight at the event site.
- ☆ Entry fees will not be refunded for dogs that are absent or that are disqualified, excused or barred from competition by action of a judge or the Event Committee. Entries cancelled prior to May 31 will be refunded less a \$25 administrative fee. Entry fees for bitches in season will be refunded less a \$25 administrative fee if a valid veterinarian's statement is submitted to the Trial Secretary by August 3. Entry fees are payable in U.S. funds only with checks or U.S. or International money orders drawn on a U.S. bank. Checks returned for insufficient funds will be charged a \$50 fee.
- ☆ Entry fees will not be refunded if the event cannot open or be completed by reason of riot, civil disturbance, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of ASPDA. ASPDA reserves the right to refuse any entry.
- ☆ This is a public event, and as such, sportsmanlike conduct and appropriate dress will be of utmost importance. Any unsportsmanlike conduct will not be tolerated.
- ☆ All rights to video tape, television, advertising, photographs or other promotions otherwise exploiting this event are solely vested in the All Star Performance Dog Association. All persons and dogs in attendance who appear in any resultant effort grant the use of their likeness and voice without further consent. Exhibitors may video tape individual performances for personal use. ***No flash photography will be allowed during competition.***
- ☆ One admission ticket will be provided for each dog entered. Dogs will be allowed in designated areas only.
- ☆ In the event of dog(s) left unattended in inadequately ventilated vehicles, ASPDA reserves the right to remove the dog(s) from the vehicle by whatever means necessary.

General Rules of Eligibility and Entry Information

This event is open to all dogs that have met the specific requirements for agility, obedience, and/or rally as stated in this premium. Aggressive dogs or dogs suffering from any illness, injury or deformity which would affect their performance are not considered eligible. Bitches in season may not compete (refer to Exhibitor Notice for refund information). Handlers or dogs not in good standing with any registry listed below are not eligible to compete. Scores submitted for entry requirement will be accepted from the allowed registries regardless of when obtained (i.e., there is no date limitation). Entries must be received on official All Star entry forms and must be legible and complete, otherwise they will not be accepted. Exhibitors will be notified via email or mail when their entry is accepted. A waiting list will be maintained through the Closing Date and exhibitors will be notified immediately when their entry is accepted.

Opening Date: entries for this event will be accepted on a first received basis as of **Wednesday, March 5, 2008 at 9:00 am EST.**

Closing Date: No withdrawals will be allowed after **Saturday, May 31, 2008 at 6:00 pm EDT.** Entries will be accepted until **Monday, June 30, 2008 at 6:00 pm EDT.**

Entry Fees: Entries are payable in U.S. funds. Only checks or U.S. or international money orders drawn on a U.S. bank can be accepted. Entries may be paid online using PayPal.

Entry Requirements

Please note the following general information:

- ☆ Scores, legs, and titles can be achieved at any time in the past. They need not be from the current year.
- ☆ For average scores, ANY three scores at that level from the same registry may be used. It need not be the three scores which qualified for the title.
- ☆ Dogs do not need to compete in multiple sports to enter All Star. Dogs may compete in one, two or all three sports!

Agility Eligibility Requirements

Open to any dog 18 months or older that has obtained at least one qualifying score in a **standard or jumpers** class in AKC, BKC or CKC Excellent, AKC Excellent Preferred, NADAC Elite, NADAC Veterans Elite, USDAA Masters, USDAA Performance III, AAC Master, AAC Masters Veterans, or ASCA Elite or has completed the UKC Agility II title. No qualifying score will be required for dogs with an AX, MX, or MACH title. Veterans, Performance III, and dogs with AKC Preferred Class titles will compete at the preferred height, but will use the SCT of the standard height as contained in this premium. There will be no jump height exceptions. **Other registries may be accepted at the discretion of the Board of Directors of the ASPDA.** All teams will adhere to the general rules of the ASPDA. **Agility Entry Limit:** 200 dogs.

Obedience Eligibility Requirements

All entry scores submitted for obedience must be from the same registry. Scores will be accepted from the following registries: American Kennel Club (AKC), Australian Shepherd Club of America (ASCA) (all breeds and mixes), Bermuda Kennel Club (BKC), Canadian Kennel Club (CKC), United Kennel Club (UKC) (including Novice C), and St. Hubert's Companion Dog Sports Program (CDSP).

Novice: 3 scores in Novice with an average of 190 or higher or one score of 193 or higher. Must have completed a CD title and may not have completed a CDX in any registry.

Open: 3 scores in Open with an average of 190 or higher or one score of 193 or higher. Must have completed a CDX title and may not have completed a UD in any registry.

Utility: 3 scores in Utility with an average of 190 or higher, one score of 193 or higher, or a UDX title. Must have completed a UD title and may not have completed an AKC OTCH.

Super Star: Must have an OTCH, UOCH, or MOTCH or 3 scores each in Open with a 190 average or higher and in Utility with a 190 average or higher or one score in each class of 193 or higher. Must have completed a UD title.

An exhibitor who has won FIRST place in Novice, Open, or Utility at the 2006 All Star Championships may not compete again in that same class in 2008; any other exhibitor may compete again in the same class. A competitor may complete the next "higher" title after the close of entries but prior to the tournament and still compete in the "lower" class.

Obedience Entry Limits: 60 *Novice*, 40 *Open*, 30 *Utility*, and 30 *Super Star*. Entry numbers per class may be adjusted based on actual entries.

Rally Eligibility Requirements

All entry scores submitted for Rally must be from the same class and registry. Scores from the A and B classes may be combined to meet entry requirements. Scores will be accepted from the following registries: American Kennel Club (AKC), Association of Pet Dog Trainers (APDT), Canadian Association of Rally Obedience (CARO), and Canadian Kennel Club (CKC).

Novice: 3 scores averaging 95/190 or higher and have earned an RN or Level 1 title but may not have earned an RA or Level 2 title prior to the close of entries.

Advanced: 3 scores averaging 95/190 or higher from the Advanced or Level 2 class and have earned an RA or Level 2 title but may not have earned an RE or Level 3 title prior to the close of entries.

Excellent: 3 scores averaging 95/190 or higher from the Excellent or Level 3 class and have earned an RA, RAE or Level 3 title.

Super Rally: 3 scores each from the Advanced/Level 2 and Excellent/Level 3 classes averaging 95/190 or higher. Dogs with an RAE title or equivalent are exempt from score requirements.

Rally Entry Limits: 40 *Novice*, 40 *Advanced*, and 40 *Excellent*.

Super Rally entries will be counted as entries in the Advanced and Excellent classes. If class limits are not reached, entry limits may be adjusted among the classes but in no case will total entries exceed 120.

Agility Rules & Scoring

Number of Runs

Four runs over two days. The first and second runs will be held on Friday, the third and fourth runs will be held on Saturday. Runs 1 and 2 will be standard courses. Run 3 will be a Hybrid course and Run 4 will be Jumpers with Weaves.

<i>Height:</i> Jumping 8 inches	11 inches or less at the withers
Jumping 12 inches	14 inches or less at the withers
Jumping 16 inches	18 inches or less at the withers
Jumping 20 inches	22 inches or less at the withers
Jumping 24 inches	greater than 22 inches at the withers

Walk Through

A 10-minute walk through will be allowed for each run. Walk through may be split at the judge's discretion.

Scoring

AKC agility rules and regulations will be used except where indicated in this premium. Score will be based on 100 points per run with faults deducted from 100 to determine the score for the run. Highest aggregate score wins, ties settled by fastest aggregate times. A dog must complete all runs to be eligible for placement or awards. Dogs fouling the ring are not eligible for placements or awards.

<i>Faults:</i> Knocked bar	5 points
Refusal	5 points
Missed contact*	5 points
Fly off seesaw	5 points
Wrong course	10 points
Grossly unsafe execution of obstacle	20 points
Perceived foul language**	50 points
Failure to complete obstacle / course	100 points
Exceeding SCT	3 point/sec
Abuse of dog**	elimination

*A missed contact will not be considered a failure to complete the obstacle.

**Perceived foul language and abuse of dog are subjective decisions made by the judge and not subject to appeal.

Obstacles

*Standard / Hybrid*** Course:* 18 to 20 obstacles will be utilized. The obstacles to be used are: Weave poles; A-frame; Dog walk; See-saw; Tire jump; Triple jump; Open tunnel; Closed tunnel (chute); Bar jump; Double jump; Panel jump. The pause table may be present on the course but will not be used as an obstacle.

*** Hybrid course will have 1 or 2 contact obstacles. This will be at the judge's discretion.

Jumpers with Weaves Course: 18 to 20 obstacles will be utilized. Obstacles that may be used are: Open tunnel; Closed tunnel (chute); Bar jump; Tire

Rally Rules and Scoring (Continued)

Novice

Novice competition will consist of exercises from the Novice class. There will be 3 courses comprising 15 stations that include 4 or 5 stationary exercises.

Advanced

Advanced competition will consist of a combination of exercises from the Novice and Advanced classes. There will be 3 courses comprising 18 stations that will include 5 or 6 stationary exercises.

Excellent

Excellent competition will consist of a combination of exercises from the Novice, Advanced and Excellent classes. There will be 3 courses comprising 20 stations that will include 6-7 stationary exercises. The Honor Exercise will be used and considered an additional exercise.

Super Rally

Super Rally will consist of the courses for both the Advanced and Excellent classes and each team will have a total of 6 runs, three in each of the respective classes.

Ultimate Rally Challenge

An Ultimate Rally Challenge will be held on Sunday. All AKC Rally stations, including the new non-regular exercises, will be used in one course. No retries will be allowed.

Complete information on the games, including how to sign up, will be included in the information booklet which will be sent to all entrants.

Rally Rules and Scoring

Rally judging will take place on Friday and Saturday morning. Unless otherwise specified, AKC Rally regulations, signs, and exercise descriptions will be used. Dogs and handlers must be able to perform all exercises in accordance with AKC Rally performance standards.

Check-in

Competitors must check in no later than 9:00 am on Friday to collect exhibitor numbers. Any exhibitor not checked in by 10:00 am on Friday will be considered absent. Exhibitors must also check in at ringside.

Judge's Briefing/Walk Through

A judge's briefing and walk through will be held 15 minutes prior to the start of each class. The briefing can be either oral or written. The walk through may be split at the discretion of the judge.

Run Order

Novice exhibitors will be randomly assigned an order within the class. Advanced and Excellent exhibitors will be randomly assigned an order within their height group. Adjustments will be made for those exhibitors with multiple dogs.

Warm-up

A warm-up ring will be provided and mild corrections will be allowed. At no time shall the exhibitors use the competition rings to practice. The use of food, corrections or other training aids not specifically allowed under AKC Rally regulations will not be allowed in competition rings. AKC rules regarding collars on the show grounds will be followed.

Scoring

Scoring for the Novice, Advanced and Excellent classes will be based on a perfect score of 100. Scoring for the Super Rally class will be based on a perfect score of 200. At the completion of each run, the total number of points deducted will be posted. The lowest total number of points deducted from the three class runs will determine placements. Times will be used to break placement ties. A run-off course will be used for ties that cannot be broken by time. Any dog fouling the ring will not be eligible for placements or awards.

Run-offs

Run-offs will be held just prior to the Rally Awards ceremony. Exhibitors will be notified, a new course (suitable for either class) set, and a judge's briefing and walk-thru held. If a tie remains at the conclusion of the run-off, the course will be run again.

jump; Double jump; Triple jump; Panel jump; Weave poles. Pause table and/or contact obstacles may be present on the course but will not be used as obstacles.

If the bar of a jump used more than once during a course falls it will not be reset and the competitors will not be penalized on the subsequent times over the jump.

Flat buckle collars with no hanging tags will be allowed. No toys, food, or other training aids will be allowed in the ring. There will be a warm-up ring.

Competitors must check in 30 minutes prior to the start of competition. If a competitor is not checked in at that time, that spot will be assigned to an alternate from the alternate list.

Obedience Rules & Scoring

Check-In

Competitors must check in by 12:00 noon on Saturday to collect exhibitor number. Any exhibitor not checked in by 12:00 noon on Saturday will be considered absent. Exhibitors must also check in at each ring.

Run Order

Novice exhibitors will be randomly assigned an order within the class. Open and Utility will be randomly assigned an order within their height division. Adjustments will be made for those exhibitors with multiple dogs. Run orders will be varied for each class and will be provided with judging details.

Warm-up

Warm-up rings with Max Trax will be provided. Mild corrections will be allowed. Exhibitors entered in obedience cannot use the agility warm-up ring and exhibitors entered in agility cannot use obedience warm-up rings. At no time shall an exhibitor use the competition rings. Toys, food or other training aids are not allowed in competition rings. All Star will follow AKC rules regarding collars on the show grounds.

Scoring

Exhibitor scoring for each exercise will be based on AKC rules. Following each class, the exhibitor's total point deduction will be posted immediately to spectators and an exercise breakdown card will be given to the exhibitor. The standings at the conclusion of Saturday's judging will be posted. Lowest total points deducted over all classes in a division will determine placement. Ties will be settled by run-offs. Any dog fouling the ring is not eligible for placements or awards. Each half of the Directed Jumping exercise will be scored as a separate exercise.

Run-offs

Before the runoffs, a list of exhibitors involved will be posted, with the order and what placements will be determined. Run-off will be an off-leash heeling pattern with no limits on how challenging the caller can make the pattern. One ring approximately 100 x 40 feet will be used with three judges. Competitors are sequestered and escorted to ring - no knowledge of pattern allowed. Total points lost from both judges will be totaled for final run-off score that will determine final placement in class and in event.

Obedience Exercises & Points

Obedience judging will take place on Saturday and Sunday. AKC obedience rules and regulations will be used except where indicated in this premium. Demo team will walk heeling pattern and will identify location of all exercises in class approximately 15 minutes before judging begins. The Awards Ceremony for obedience winners will be held on Sunday afternoon.

Novice Division

Novice competition will consist of three classes—one on Saturday and two on Sunday. All classes will be the normal order of exercises. Novice exhibitors will complete two sets of group stays, one on Saturday and one on Sunday.

Open Division

Open competition will consist of three classes—one on Saturday and two on Sunday. One class will be Order #1. The other two classes will be mixed order to be posted one half hour before competition for that round begins. Open exhibitors will complete two sets of group stays, one on Saturday and one on Sunday.

Utility Class

Utility competition will consist of three classes—one on Saturday and two on Sunday. One class will be Order #1. The other two classes will be mixed order to be posted one half hour before competition for that round begins.

Super Star Class

Super Star competition will consist of five classes—two on Saturday and three on Sunday. Each class will be a mix of six Open and Utility exercises. Each exercise in Open and Utility will be done three times during the tournament. The exercise choice and order will be posted one half hour before competition for that round begins. Super Star exhibitors will complete two sets of group stays, one on Saturday and one on Sunday.

"All Star Perfect Class" Award:

There will be an award(s) for the "All Star Perfect Class" for receiving all of the points possible in that class (this may not be equal to 200 in the case of Super Star). In the case of Novice, Open, and Super Star, the group stay exercise done on the same day must be perfect for any of the rounds done on that day to be eligible for the "Perfect Round" award.

Scent Discrimination—Used articles will be bagged after each class. Competitors have the option of using the same articles or a fresh set in subsequent classes.

Stays—All stays will be in the order SIT then DOWN. All group stays will be held in a ring designated for that purpose and will be done at the conclusion of judging of that class on that day.
